This is in response to your letter of September 27, 2002, to the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) asking that we "provide written verification our program meets federal requirements." We deeply regret the delay in responding.

You are correct in stating that OSHA does not "grant letters of approval," nor do we promote or endorse any products, training, or programs.

OSHA recognizes any nationally accepted and medically sound first aid program that covers first aid fundamentals as meeting the requirements in 29CFR 1910.151. The specific content of first aid programs must be consistent with work environments and the type of work in question.
